

COMPREHENSIVE IMPLANT TRAINING FOR THE GENERAL DENTIST

Taeheon Kang, D.D.S., M.S. – Born and raised in South Korea, Kang attended Seoul National University Dental School—the most prestigious program in the country. Inspired by the fields of periodontics and implant dentistry, he went on to receive his specialty training in periodontics from Seoul National University in 1996. After earning his certificate in periodontics, he relocated to the United States. He then attended the University of Pennsylvania, where he received his second training in periodontics and implant dentistry. As a result, Kang is the only periodontist who has completed a periodontal residency in both Korea and the United States. After eight years of his dedication and commitment to the University of Pennsylvania and Nova Southeastern University as an educator and a clinician, he opened his private practice in Fairfax, Virginia.



Omar Abdo, D.D.S., M.S., FACP – Abdo, who maintains a private practice in Jupiter, Florida, is a specialist in cosmetic veneers and restorations, crown and bridge, dentures, partials, full-mouth reconstructions, maxillofacial prosthodontics, and implant dentistry. He is a board-certified prosthodontist, a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics, and a Fellow of the American College of Prosthodontists. Currently, he holds faculty appointments with the University of Illinois, Marquette University School of Dentistry, and Nova Southeastern University College of Dental Medicine. He is a graduate of the University of Illinois at Chicago with graduate specialty training in advanced combined prosthodontics and earned his Master of Science degree in Oral Science at the University of Illinois Graduate College.
