Omar Abdo, D.D.S., M.S., FACP – Abdo, who maintains a private practice in Jupiter, Florida, is a specialist in cosmetic veneers and restorations, crown and bridge, dentures, partials, full-mouth reconstructions, maxillofacial prosthodontics, and implant dentistry. He is a board-certified prosthodontist, a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics, and a Fellow of the American College of Prosthodontists. He held faculty appointments at Marquette University School of Dentistry, the University of Illinois, and Nova Southeastern University College of Dental Medicine.
